## **United Educators Credit Union Participated in Statewide Day of Kindness**

Apple Valley, Minn. – On Monday, October 9, United Educators Credit Union joined 37 other Minnesota credit unions and partners dedicating a total of 12,224 volunteer hours in 80 Minnesota communities with an estimated impact on more than 33,574 people.

Staff members from UECU spent the day volunteering at Twin Cities Kids In Need Resource Center in Roseville packing boxes filled with school supplies for teachers to use in their classrooms.
