



2018/2019 United Educators Foundation Financial Literacy Grants

The United Educators Foundation is pleased to offer up to **\$2,000 in grants** to teachers, departments or schools who are promoting financial literacy to their students. Submitted grants should support instruction of content related to budgeting, credit, money management, economics, saving and investing, or other personal finance topic. **Grant funds will be awarded via a check of up to \$500.**

- All grades (K-12) and subjects at an accredited Minnesota school are eligible. Grant money can be used to support either a new or existing plan that has not previously received a grant from United Educators Credit Union or United Educators Foundation.
- Deadline for application: **Postmarked by December 14, 2018**. Completed applications may be mailed to United Educators Foundation, Attn: Grant Selection Committee, 11599 Robinson Drive NW, Coon Rapids, MN 55433. Incomplete applications and those postmarked later than December 14, 2018 will not be considered. Applications may also be delivered in person to any United Educators Credit Union office on or before the deadline.
- Application materials should be typed or computer word-processed before being submitted.
- Grants will be awarded in early 2019 and winners will be notified by January 31, 2019.
- Grant must be used in the 2018/2019 School Year.
- No single school will receive more than one grant per school year.
- Grant funds will be awarded via a check of up to \$500 made out directly to the school.
- United Educators Foundation Board members, United Educators Credit Union Board and Committee members, United Educators Credit Union staff, or any immediate family members of those noted above, are not eligible to apply.

Grant recipient agreement

Once applications are received they are considered property of the Foundation. The grant recipients agree to have their names, school names and description of their programs used in foundation newsletters and other publications.
