### **ANNOUNCING THE 2015 UNITED EDUCATORS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Woodbury, Minn. - United Educators Foundation is now accepting applications for its annual High School student, Education Major student, and Educator Scholarship Awards. Applications are available on United Educators Credit Union's website at [www.uecu.coop/scholarship](http://www.uecu.coop/scholarship), and are due Friday, February 13, 2015.

#### **Student Awards:**

The Foundation provides three \$1,000 college scholarships to graduating high school seniors who are United Educators Credit Union members or the children, grandchildren, or other dependents of members. Applicants must be planning to attend a university, college, community college or technical college in the fall of 2015.

#### **Education Major Award:**

One \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to a student majoring in Education and entering their *Junior* or *Senior* year in the fall of 2015. Applicants must be attending an accredited college or university in the state of Minnesota *or* be a United Educators Credit Union member or the child or grandchild of a member. *This award is available to non-UECU members.*

#### **Educator Award:**

One \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a United Educators Credit Union member for the purpose of professional development in the education field. Applicants must have worked a minimum of 6 months in the field, and must plan to attend an accredited institution within one year of receiving the award.
